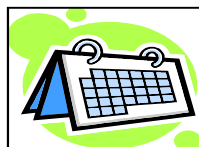

Woody Allen’s Classic Comedy Opens La Canada Playhouse Season

The La Canada High School Theatre Department is set to perform “Don’t Drink The Water,” Woody Allen’s critically acclaimed comedy about a dysfunctional family whose summer vacation goes awry. When the Hollanders take one too many photos while passing through a Communist country on their tour of Europe, they seek refuge in an American embassy filled with madcap characters and tons of laughs! “This lighthearted look at the Cold War remains Allen’s finest comedic effort for the stage and is perfect for audiences of all ages” says director Justin Eick. The production is beautifully enhanced by the set which features a magnificent Victorian mansion that serves as the embassy in the play.

Written by Woody Allen in 1966, “Don’t Drink The Water” was Allen’s first play and ran for more than a year originally on Broadway. Since then, the production has been revived countless times in theatres throughout the county in addition to two film versions in 1969 and 1994.

This limited engagement runs October 26th through 28th with performances beginning at 7:00 pm. Playing at the La Canada Playhouse (formerly the Auditorium) at La Canada High School, tickets are just \$10.00 and the doors to the theatre open fifteen minutes before curtain for open seating.
